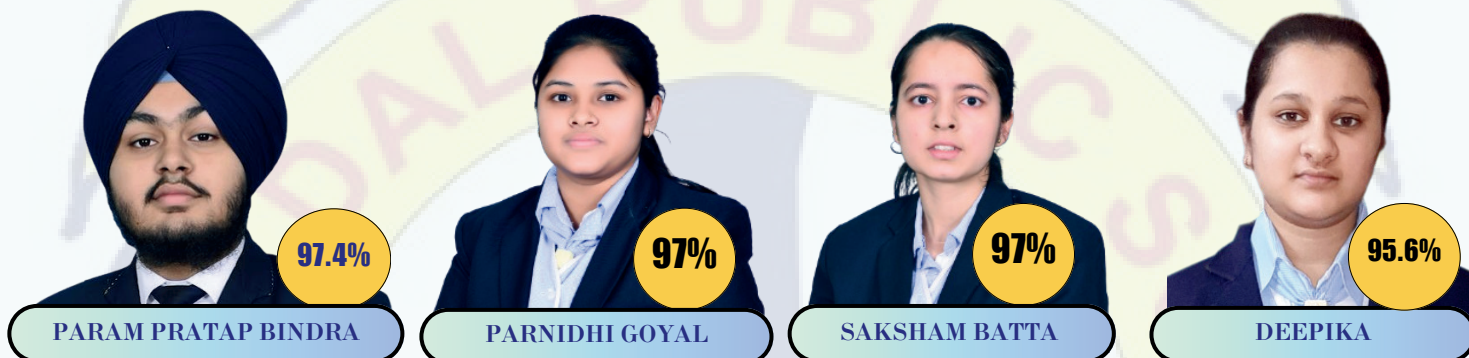

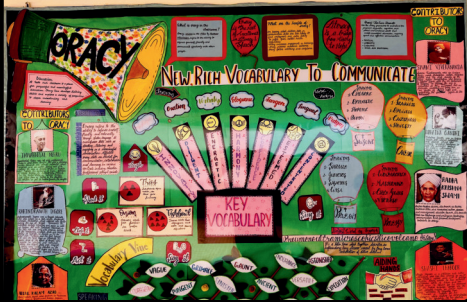

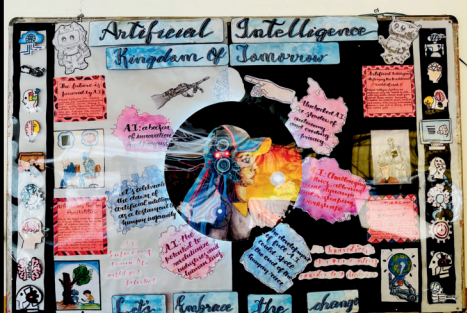
BULLETIN BOARD COMPETITION

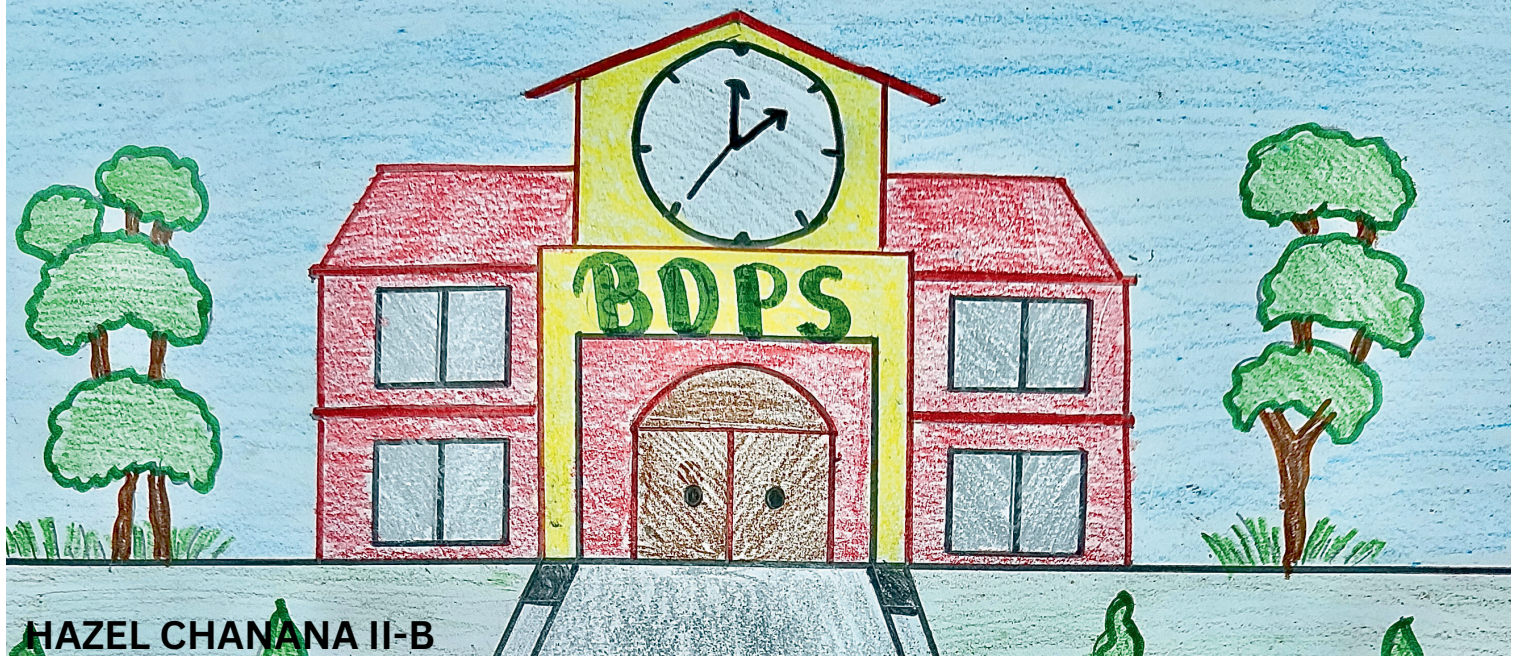
IF I COULD TRAVEL ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD

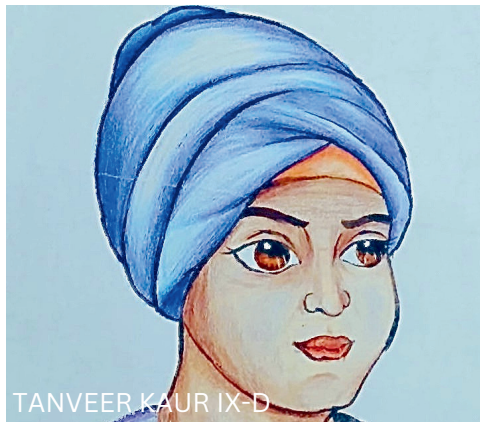
