Topic: Database Development (Basic)

Month-April-2021

Previous knowledge: - to check the knowledge teacher will ask basic questions regarding the topic like:-

1. What the student understand by term storage?
2. What is data?
3. What is information?
4. What are records?

Vocabulary used:-data, database, dbms, flat file, primary key, foreign key, and relational database.

Important spelling used: - integer, varchar, boolean, binary.

Aids/methods used to explain the topic :- smart board, e-book, textbook, chalkboard.

Procedure: - topic wise chapter will be read aloud in class and teacher will explain the topic. Teacher will show diagrams on smart board to explain the topic. Important terms and required figure will be drawn on board like:

Short cut keys:

The writing skills related to phrases, kind of sentences, parts of sentence and uses of articles will be explained.


